

REGULATION E RULES GOVERNING PLAYERS, COACHES, AND SUPPORT OFFICIALS

E.1 Eligibility of Players

- E.1.1 To be entitled to participate in ACG competitions, a player must observe the Internal Regulations of ACG.
- E.1.2 The Asian Community Games committee is responsible for the eligibility of its players at all times and will bear the consequences of any infractions of the Regulations governing Eligibility, and Age of Players.
- E.1.3 All players who participate in competitions of ACG must:
 - a. Respect the spirit of fair play and non violence and act accordingly at all times on the court.
 - b. Refrain from using substances and from practices prohibited by the regulations of Asian Community Games.
 - c. Agree to submit at any time to medical tests and controls, particularly doping controls, carried out in compliance with the regulations of ACG.
- E.1.4 An Asian Community Games committee member is authorized to deny participation in competitions under its jurisdiction to players who do not respect the provisions provided for in E.1.3 above.
- E.1.5 Players in breach of the principles set out in E.1.3 a., b., and c. may not be eligible to participate in any competition in Asian Community Games.
- E.1.6 No financial remuneration for the performances of a player or a team is permitted during the Asian Community Games.

E.2 National Status of Players

E.2.1 General Principles

E.2.1.1 These regulations apply to all competitions of ACG.

E.2.1.2 These regulations apply to both genders.

E.2.1.3 ACG committee remains the right to decide whether a player is eligible to participate in any events.

E.2.2 Proof of nationality

E.2.2.1 ACG may ask that evidence be provided to verify the nationality (or nationalities) of any player by requesting any documents it deems appropriate.

E.3 Eligibility of team

E.3.1 Team regulations

E.3.1.1 Two maximum teams from each community are allowed to participate in the event.

E.3.1.2 Teams from the same community may not play in the same group of fixtures.

E.3.1.3 Minimum of six players and maximum of 12 players in each team including a captain are allowed.

E.3.1.4 Each team is allowed to have maximum of five team followers on the team bench with special responsibilities (e.g. coach, manager, doctor, interpreter etc.)

E.3.1.5 Each participating team must fill out the application form with all details inquired and submitted to the ACG committee before the deadline.

E.3.1.6 Each separate team is responsible to provide \$300 entrance fee despite from the same community and submitted to the ACG committee before the deadline.

E.3.1.7 Eligible teams are expected to provide their own uniforms in both dark and light colors for efficient team distinguishing on the court.

E.3.1.8 Each participating teams are encouraged to come up with a unique team name to be recognized during the event.



E.3.2 Player regulations

- E.3.2.1 Players in all ages are welcome to participate in ACG, however individuals who are 18 years or younger are required a signature of release by parent or guardian.
- E.3.2.2 Each player from participating teams are required to sign the waiver form accompanied with the registration form.
- E.3.2.3 Each player from participating teams are required to provide true contact information including phone number and e-mail address on the registration form.
